Read Genesis 3:1-10, 21-24

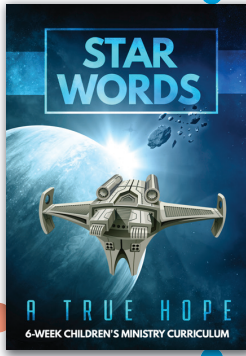
Answer these questions:

(K - 3rd Grade)

1. What rule did God give Adam and Eve to follow?
Do not eat from the forbidden fruit.
2. What happened when Adam and Eve disobeyed God?
Sin enter the world
3. Who is the one person who can forgive our sins?
God sent Jesus to forgive us our sins
4. How does God help us resist sin?
Help us become wise, give us strength to say no and give us the endurance we need to fight against sin
5. Is there one sin you want to give to God and ask his help to say no to this week?
(Ask kids for answers) Leaders start by giving an example

(4th & 5th Grade)

1. Why do you think Adam and Eve disobeyed God?
The snake fooled Eve and they thought they knew what was best
2. Why do all of us struggle with sin?
As Humans, we sometimes get fooled/distracted of what God asks from us
3. How can we have our sins forgiven?
God sent Jesus to forgive us our sins
4. How can God help us to resist sin?
He will give us the strength to say No!
5. Is there one sin you want to give to God and ask his help to say no to this week?
(Ask kids for answers) Leaders start by giving an example

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: SIN



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask the kids how they can spot a villain in Star Wars. How do they know someone is evil? How can God help us to learn to spot sin so we can avoid it?



AT DINNER:

- How can God help us to resist sin?
