Read Psalms 138

Answer these questions:

(K - 3rd Grade)

1. Why did David write this Psalm?

To praise God for everything He’s done for David

2. What were some things David was thankful for?

God’s unfailing love, kept promises, encouragement, grace, care for the humble

3. Why is it important to thank God for his blessings?

Everything good we have comes from Him, and we show Him we love Him by thanking Him

4. Can you think of three things you are thankful for?

Leaders/Parents- share some ideas to start the ball rolling for the kids

5. What is something you can do to show God you are thankful for one of those blessings?

Prayers of thanksgiving, “paying it forward”, making sure we share the blessings we have, etc

(4th & 5th Grade)

1. What were some things David was thankful for?

God’s unfailing love, kept promises, encouragement, grace, care for the humble

2. How were David’s blessings different from the blessings God has given you?

We aren’t in charge of armies or kings, but God still blesses us with grace, protection, love. Our tangible blessings may just look different.

3. Why is it important to thank God for his blessings?
