Answer these questions:

(K - 3rd Grade)

1. Why did Pharaoh chase after the Israelites?

They complaint to God and asked Moses why he led them to die in the desert
3. What did God tell Moses to do?
To part the sea by raising his staff to provide dry passage for the Israelites
4. How did God save Israel from Egypt?
He parted the sea so the Israelites could escape before the Egyptians got swept away
5. Can God still do big miracles today?
Yes, miracles occur all the time and most of them take place in the lives of individual people
