



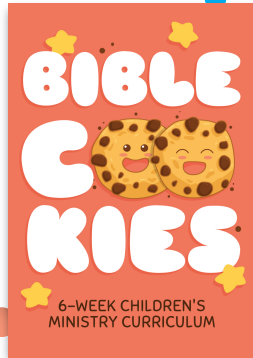
WEEK 5 BIBLE STUDY

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Fudge Stripes have three important parts: chocolate covered base, cookie, and stripes. Each does its part to make the cookie tasty and fun! But imagine if one of these parts were missing - it wouldn't be a Fudge Stripe cookie! The parable of the three servants teaches us that no matter what gifts God gives us, he wants us to use those things for Him and for His kingdom. Matthew 25:14-30, Three Servants Investing Money
