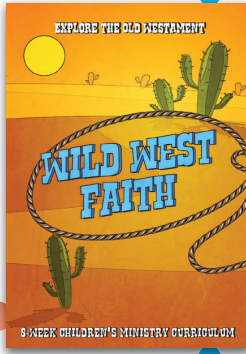

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When enemies confront each other in a Wild West town, you might hear the phrase, "This town ain't big enough for the both of us." Someone had to go.
