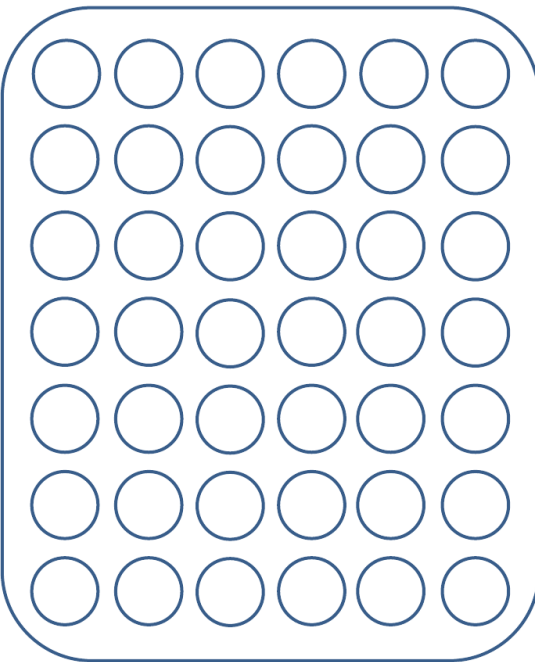

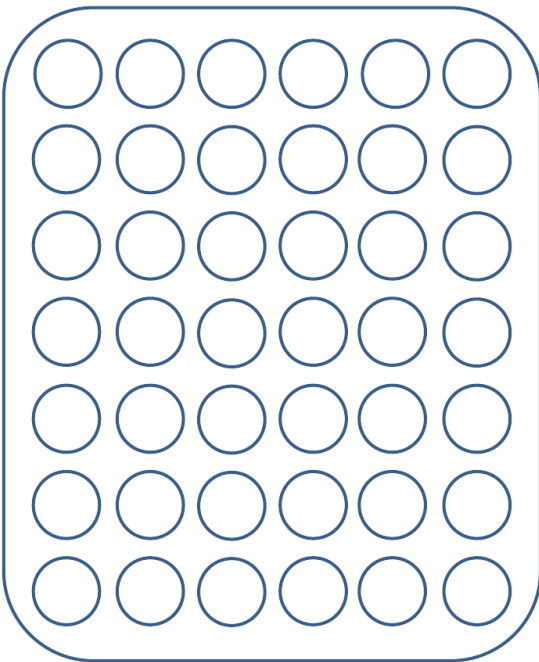
## CONNECT 4 LINE GAME

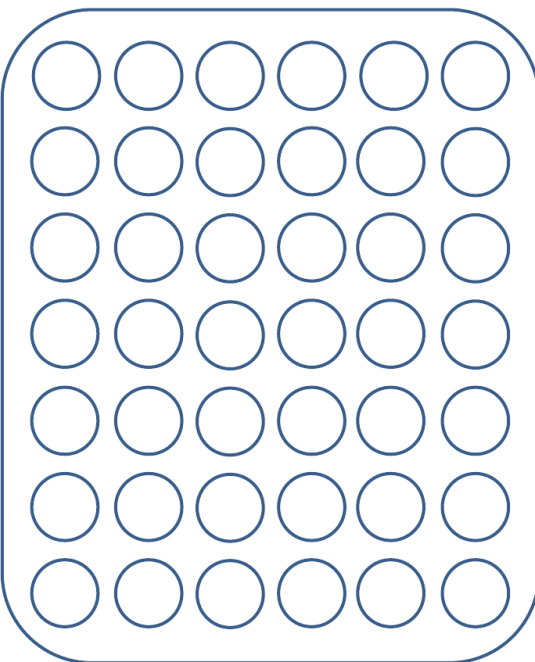
