Read Genesis 12: 1-8

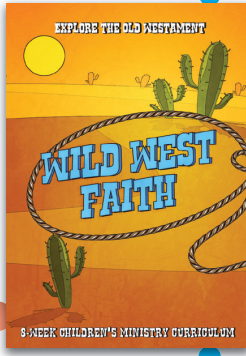
Answer these questions:

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:
