#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: If you want your finished project to look the way it does on the box, you had better follow the directions. In our lives, we need to follow God's direction. 1 Kings 17:7-24, Elijah and the Widow.

### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Let the kids help with a project around the house that requires following directions, be it assembling a new purchase or making a recipe. Ask them what would happen if any direction was changed or skipped. What would the consequences be?

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:


