Memory Verse: "Taste and see that the lord is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him." Psalm 34:8


Read John 5: 1-15 *Answer these questions:*

"Taste and see that the Lord is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him." Psalm 34:8




PARENT TIME:
