THIS WEEK'S LESSON: COMING KING



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

People were drawn to Jesus because they thought he was coming as a king to free them from the Romans. Jesus was coming as king, but he chose to ride on a donkey to symbolize that he was coming in peace. Even though they were drawn to him, the people did not realize that Jesus was coming to free them from something even bigger than the Romans. He was coming to free them from their sins. Mark 11:1-10, Jesus Enters Jerusalem

"But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners." Romans 5:8

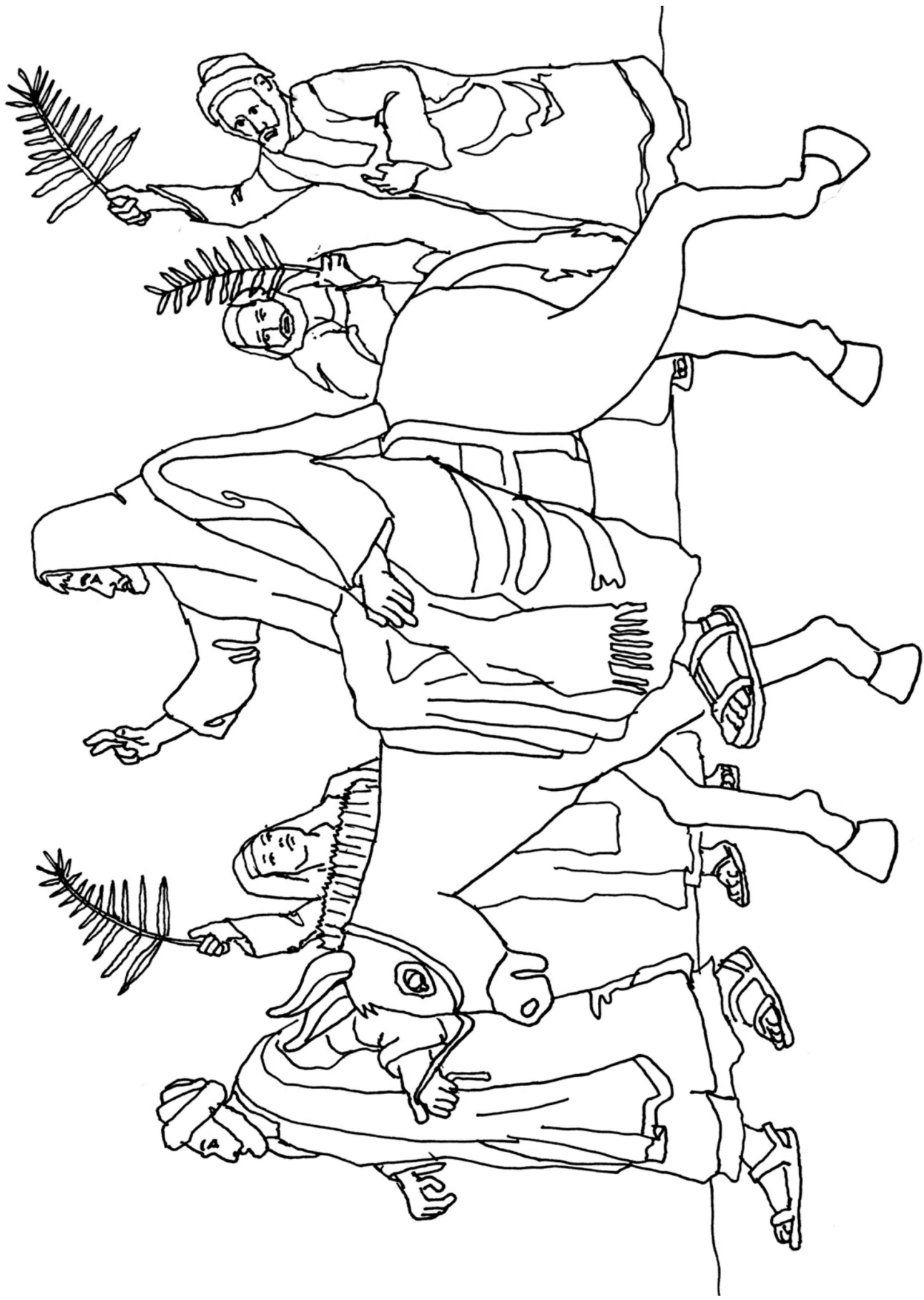


PARENT TIME:
