WEEK 1 BIBLE STUDY

Memory Verse: "Give thanks to the Lord and proclaim his greatness. Let the whole world know what he has done." 1 Chronicles 16:8

Read Jeremiah 1

Answer these questions:

(K - 3rd Grade)

1. What did God say to Jeremiah?

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet of the nations."

2. What excuses did Jeremiah give when God spoke to him?

"I do not know how to speak; I am too young."

3. How did God answer that excuse?

"Don't say I am too young, you must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you."

4. How did God use Jeremiah to help Israel?

"Jeremiah helped the people of Israel to turn from their sins and repent."

5. What is one talent or gift God has given you that you are thankful for?

(Examples: writing, singing, drawing, encouraging, listening, caring for others, cooking)

(4th & 5th Grade)

1. What did God call Jeremiah to do?

Called him to be a prophet. To turn the people of Israel back to God, repent, stop worshiping false gods.

2. What excuses did Jeremiah give when God spoke to him?

"I do not know how to speak; I am too young."

3. How did God answer those excuses?

"Don't say I am too young, you must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you."

4. What is one talent or gift God has given you that you are thankful for?

(Examples: writing, singing, drawing, encouraging, listening, caring for others, cooking)

5. How can you show God you are thankful by using that gift for him?

(Examples: Praying to God & thanking Him, use talents to bring others to Christ)

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

- How did Jeremiah use those gifts for God?
- How can we thank God for the gifts he has given us?
