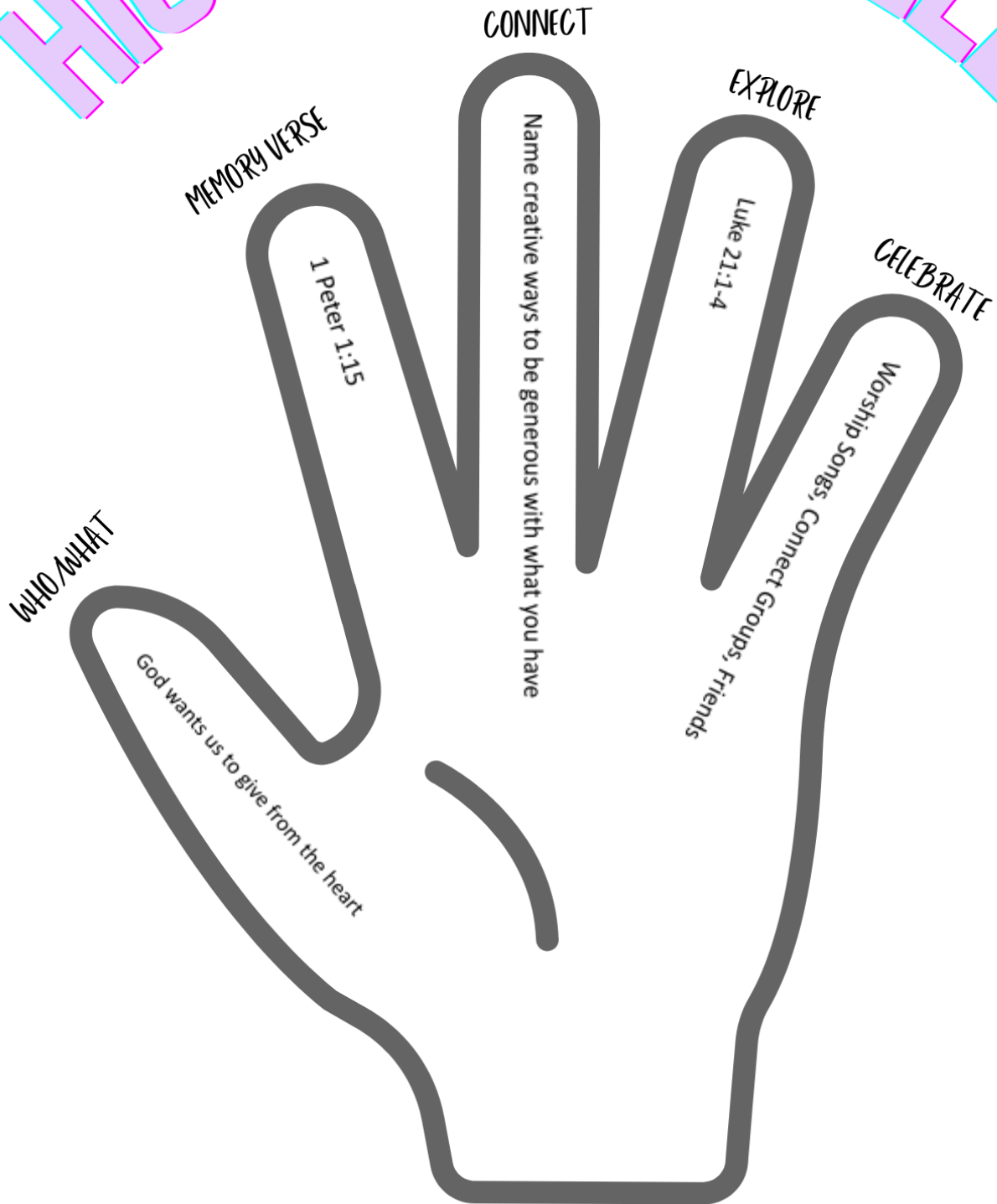


# HIGH FIVE RETELL

**Read Luke 21:1-4**

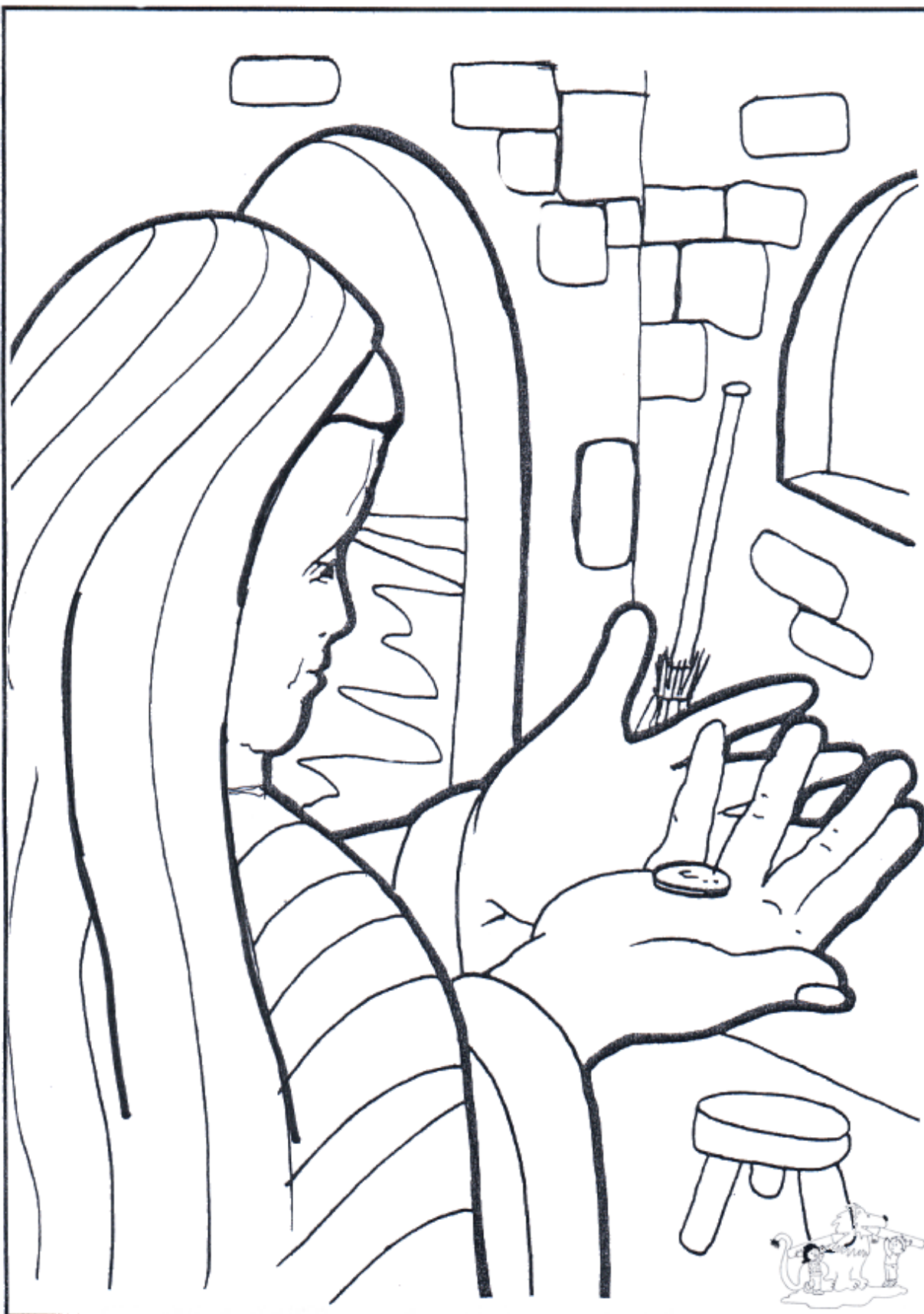
*Answer these questions:*

**(1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade)**

1. Who put more actual money into the offering plate?  
The rich people
2. Whom did Jesus say put more into the plate?  
The widow, because she gave everything she had
3. Why did Jesus say the widow’s gift was more than the other gifts?  
She has given everything she had compared to the rich people who gave a fraction of what they had.
4. How does God want us to give?  
From our hearts, we give to God because we love Him
5. What are some creative ways we can give from the heart?  
**\*\*Ask Kids\*\*** Ex: Giving without being asked, share with others before yourself

**(4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Grade)**

1. Why did Jesus say the widow’s gift was more than the other gifts?

2. Why does how we give matter more than how much we give?  
Giving from the abundance of your heart is more important than impressing others on how much
3. Why is sacrifice important to God when we give?
