Read Luke 21:1-4 *Answer these questions:*

(1st - 3rd Grade)

- 1. Who put more actual money into the offering plate? The rich people
- 2. Whom did Jesus say put more into the plate? The widow, because she gave everything she had
- 3. Why did Jesus say the widow's gift was more than the other gifts? She has given everything she had compared to the rich people who gave a fraction of what they had.
- 4. How does God want us to give? From our hearts, we give to God because we love Him
- 5. What are some creative ways we can give from the heart? **Ask Kids** Ex: Giving without being asked, share with others before yourself

(4th & 5th Grade)

- 1. Why did Jesus say the widow's gift was more than the other gifts? She has given everything she had compared to the rich people who gave a fraction of what they had.
- 2. Why does how we give matter more than how much we give? Giving from the abundance of your heart is more important than impressing others on how much
- 3. Why is sacrifice important to God when we give? Your sacrifice shows God your obedience and willingness to trust Him
- 4. How many of you are in the habit of giving regularly to church and/or charity? **Ask Kids**
- 5. What are some creative ways we can give from the heart? **Ask Kids** Ex: Giving without being asked, share with others before yourself
