Read Genesis 12: 1-8

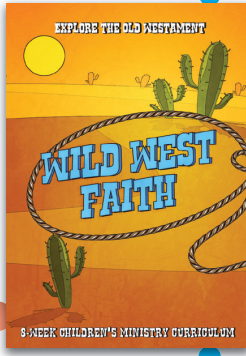
Answer these questions:

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

The young David met the giant Goliath for a showdown on the battlefield – Goliath with his spear and heavy armor, David with only a few stones and a sling. David met his adversary with confidence in the Lord in the most famous showdown in history. 1 Samuel 17:25-49, David and Goliath
