THIS WEEK'S LESSON: BAD EGG



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

The disciples loved and followed Jesus. So many were surprised when Judas Iscariot turned out to be a “bad egg,” betraying Jesus in exchange for 30 pieces of silver. Judas’ story teaches us that nothing should ever become more important to us than our relationship with Jesus. Luke 22:1-6, 45-52, Judas Betrays Jesus



HANGING OUT:

Make this week’s lesson real:

Do this week’s egg-speriment with your kids. Get a raw egg and hard-boiled egg, and see if they can tell which is which without cracking them. Ask them what made Judas a “bad egg.”



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did Judas betray Jesus?
- Why is it important to put Jesus first ahead of our own wants?
- How could Judas have been a good egg instead of a bad one?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week’s memory verse:

PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Judas followed Jesus for three years, but he never picked up the vision Jesus had for him and his life. Judas put himself and his desires first, and that led to him betraying Jesus. Ask God to help you determine if there’s something you are putting ahead of Jesus, and ask God for help setting things right.
