Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

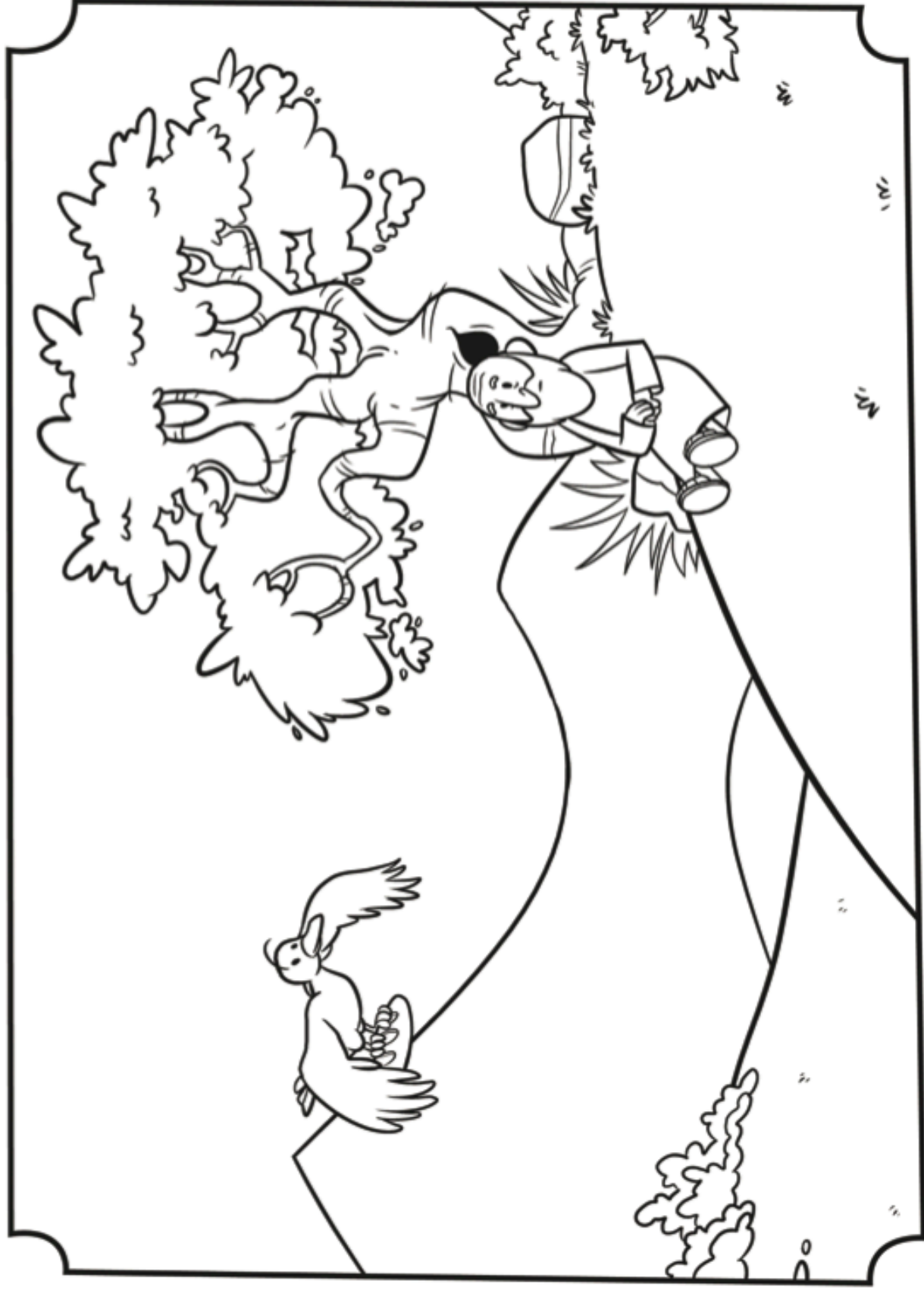
