




### WEEK 4 BIBLE STUDY

#### IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

The more we learn God's word, the more we see that there is so much to learn. As we study, we find that there are always new things to see and deeper places that we can go. We are detectives, working to uncover the deeper meanings. As we study God's word, we learn that it all leads us to Jesus, the Living Word of God. John 1:1-18, The Word



#### HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kids how much they have read the Bible outside of church over the last several weeks. Ask them what you can do to help them stay in the habit of reading their Bibles.



#### AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why does John describe Jesus as being the Word?
- How does the Word teach us about Jesus?
- What have you learned about God in the last several weeks?



#### AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:
