WEEK 4 BIBLE STUDY

Read John 15:1-12 *Answer these questions:*

(K - 3rd Grade)

- 1. Who is the vine, and who is the gardener? Jesus is the vine, and God the father is the gardener
- 2. What does the gardener do in this parable? He prunes all the branches
- 3. What happens to the vines that do not produce fruit? He cuts off the branches
- 4. What happens when you stay connected to Jesus? You will produce much fruit
- 5. What can we do to stay connected and grow more like Jesus? Read God's word, and pray. When we obey God's commandments in his word then we remain in his love.

(4th & 5th Grade)

 Why does Jesus describe Himself as a vine? Our growth in our faith is dependent on our connection to Jesus, just like a fruit's growth is dependent on the health and upkeep of the vine.
