"For every house has a builder, but the one who built everything is God." Hebrews 3:4

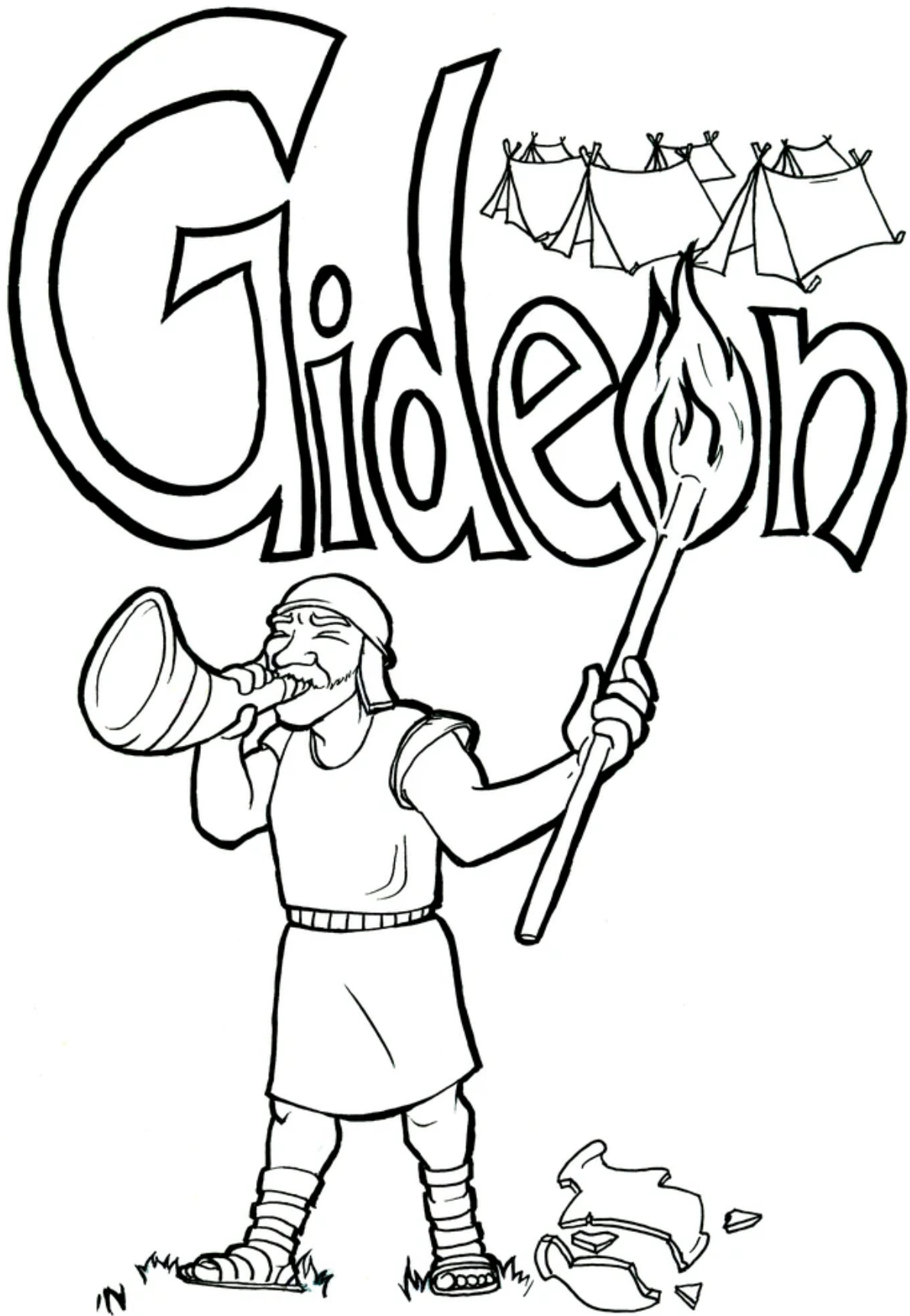


PARENT TIME:
