



Bunny Dirt Pies


1 (8oz) block of cream cheese
1/2 cup butter
1 cup powdered sugar
2 (3oz) boxes instant French Vanilla pudding
3 1/2 cups cold milk
1 (12 oz) container Cool Whip
1 package of Oreos

Directions: At room temperature mix the cream cheese, margarine, powdered sugar. In a separate bowl, beat the pudding and milk until thickened. Then fold in Cool Whip in pudding mixture. Combine pudding bowl with cream cheese mixture. Crush the Oreos into fine crumbs with a food processor or in a Ziplock bag. In small clear cups, make several layers of Oreos and then the cream cheese mixture. Top or decorate with Easter Peeps and candy eggs. Refrigerate until ready to eat.

Easter Crafts



Supplies Needed:

Cardboard
Scissors
Tin Foil
Colored Sharpies

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out an egg shape from your cardboard.
- 2. Tear off a piece of tin foil from your roll. Lay your egg on top of it and then fold the tin foil edges over the egg all over so the front of the egg is completely covered in the foil.
- 3. Leaving the lid on the Sharpie marker, have your child use it to draw lines and designs all over the tin foil Easter egg.
- 4. When they are finished drawing designs, they can use all of the Sharpie markers to trace over their designs and add any more details that they'd like.

Easter Crafts



Materials

cross template
paper plate
craft paint (color of your choice)
yarn paint (color of your choice)
pencil
tape
paint brush

Tools

scissors craft knife hole punch plastic yarn needle

Instructions:

- 1. Start by painting the paper plate and set it aside to dry completely.
- 2. Draw out a cross in the middle of the painted paper plate.







- 3. Use a craft knife to cut out the cross. (This is an adult only step)
- 4. Use a hole punch to make holes along the four ends of the cross.
- 5. Cut a strand of yarn, thread it through the plastic yarn needle and tie one end to the needle. Tape the other end of the yarn at the back of the paper plate. You can now start threading the yarn through the holes in the paper plate. You can go through the holes once or several times. Keep on threading until you reach the end of your yarn. Secure the end of the yarn to the back of the paper plate with tape.

We started with the crossbar and then moved to the vertical part. Kids can intertwine the yarn or not, depending on their age.
